Rector's Message

Dear all,

We have exciting news! After much thought and prayerful consideration, we have decided to hire a part-time Christian Education Director to help us better nurture and serve the youth of Christ Church. The Vestry approved the creation of this new position based on a firm commitment to the youth of this parish. Furthermore, the Vestry is committed to the growth of this parish and feels strongly that the Christian Education program is integral to that growth. Having a strong staff member in this position is, if not *the* key, one of the most important keys to growing our parish and moving it forward.

The Vestry commissioned a committee to design the position and has approved the position description created by that committee. The position description has been mailed to each household with this letter. This description will have to be

tweaked, based upon the skills of the Director and what can realistically be accomplished within (an average of) 18 hours per week. To

begin, this position will be funded by endowment monies, which Bill Johnson and Wesley & Lillias Talkington so generously and graciously gave to the church several years ago.

We are first opening this position within the congregation and to anyone outside of the congregation who you might recommend. **The deadline to submit resumes to the Parish Office is Friday, August 19th.** Questions can be directed to me or any Vestry member.

In addition, we are forming a Christian Education Committee, which will lead us in our support of our Director and the Christian Education program. If you would like to serve on this committee or if you would like to recommend another member of the parish to serve on the committee, please let me know as soon as possible.

We are excited about this endeavor and about the possibilities a Christian Education Director on staff will bring to our youth and to the parish as a whole.
