## Building Project Update

Two parts of the building project have been completed:

- repairs to the organ were completed on Thursday, February 4<sup>th</sup>
- drainage repairs were completed on Friday, February 19<sup>th</sup>

The next phase of the project, which is about to begin, includes:

- electrical upgrades
- installation of a heating and cooling system for the Parish Hall & Kitchen, Offices, Sunday School Classrooms and the Nursery/Choir Room area
- installation of a fire alarm system

Then after the Magnetic Church Conference we're hosting in mid-April:

- the kitchen and bathrooms will be redone
- handicapped entrances to the Church and Parish Hall and a few parking spaces along 9<sup>th</sup> Street will be put in
- all the red doors will be brought up to fire code
